Welcome & Review

When you hear the fire alarm sound:

- 1). Put on your vest & grab your coat, keys, purse, etc.
- 2). Do a sweep of your floor/designated area
- 3). Make your way to the nearest exit and leave the building
- 4). Help move/keep occupants away from the building especially from the main doors.
- 5). When the alarms have been silenced, you may let the occupants re-enter the building.

Shelter in Place - General

- Take shelter in either an office, stairwell, or other room that is safe and close the door.
- Call 911 and report the following to the CCPS communications operator:
 1. Your location
 2. That the fire alarm is sounding in your location and you will not be able to exit the building
 3. The number of people that will be staying in the building
 4. A call back number where you can be reached for updates if needed

*911 calls made from cell phones will be directed to the London Comm. Centre NOT CCPS

Alarms and Strobes

In the WSS section of the building, the flashing strobe lights may continue to flash for a short while after the fire alarms have been silenced.

As long as the bells have been turned off, it is safe to re-enter the building even if the lights are still flashing.

Fire Extinguisher Training

- Free sessions are available monthly (Check out the Fire Safety website for more info)
- P- Pull the Pin
- A – Aim at the base of the flames
- S – Squeeze the handle
- S – Sweep side to side
- Demo
